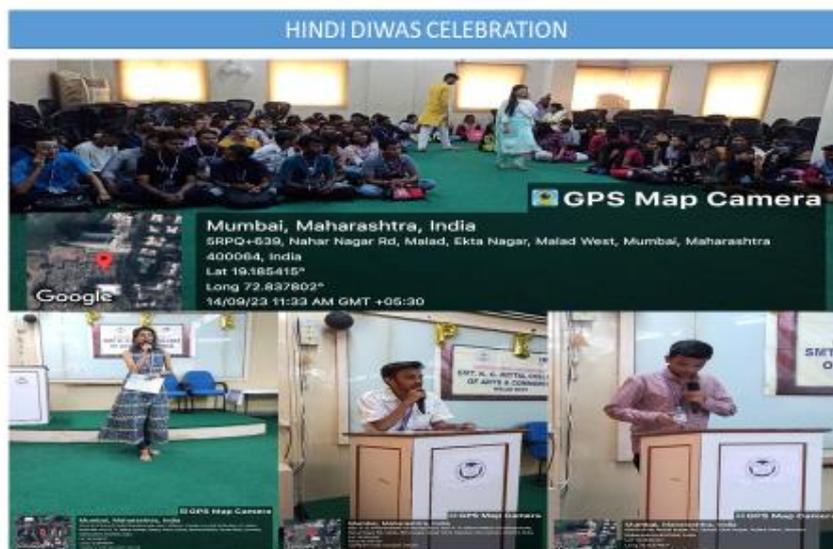
Fresher's Party

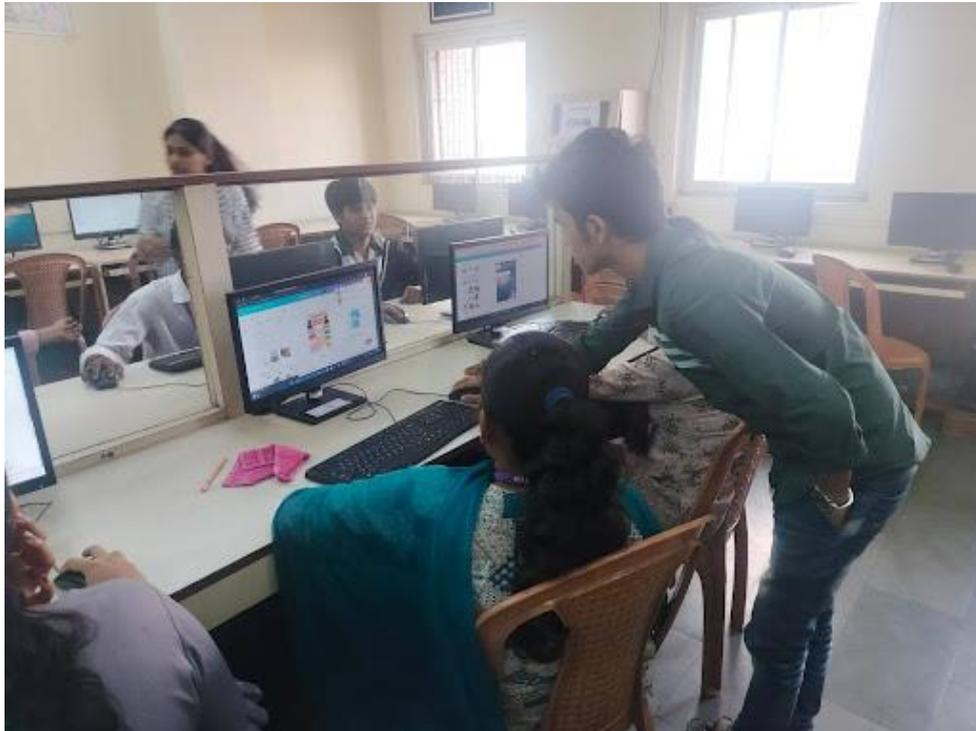
